At present we have six Locals over 100%. (V-1123, V-1031, V-231, V-542, V-605, & V-1055) I know the report shows five but I know V-1031 has turned in three renewals that have not been counted. This is one of the problems I see with everything going to National instead of through the Grand Correspondant.

A new report is sent out each week and sometimes it takes National two or more weeks to get the information back to the Grand Correspondant so he can update the membership rooster. Thanks to all six Locals for and outstanding job on helping us grow. This kind of work is what it will take to make Grand du Texas and La Societe great.

We have three at 100% and they are (V-1185, V-312 & V-1096). I want to thank them for a great job and ask that they work hard to reach a goal of 109%. Because this is what it takes to grow.

We have eight that have not made goal. (V-939, V-1601, V-163, V-266, V-980, V-175, V-1077 & V-1134). Out of these four only need 1 to get 100%. I would like to thank them for the work they have done and ask that they keep working to get to goal.

As I said before some of you may have already turned in membership to National and the Grand Correspondant has not received it yet.

We only have a couple of months left to make goal. I still can not figure out why members can not pay there dues in June or July of each year to make it easer for the Local to make goal. As I have said before if you need help with your dues please let us know. Membership is everyone's responsibility but paying your dues on time is your responsibility. As Kathy keeps telling me GET-R- DONE.

Each Division has to elect its own Chef de Train. You need to pick someone in your division that will work all year long with the Locals in your Division and help in any way to assure they achieve goal. Also help in starting up a New Voiture in your Division.

If you are going to accept a position for one of our programs then be sure to know the job and willing to work it. If you are not going to put 100% into the position then please don't accept it. If you need help then ask, that is what we are all here for. Our Programs are our biggest tool in recruiting new members so these have to be worked to show that we are not just setting at the bar.

I hope that everyone will take some part at the Local and Grand level to keep Grand du Texas and La Societe on the move.

We are behind on Box Car from last year. Every Voyageur should have a crew card and pin. If you do not then please have your Local order some. Attached is a list of where the money is spent each year at National. With Box Car all monies are spend at National and none is carried over for the next year. As you can see this supports a lot of things so please get a card and pin. And you can also make a donation from you are your Local.
